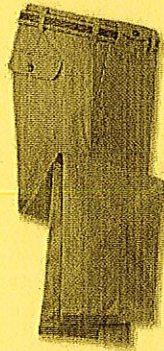


# Welcome, Rising 6<sup>th</sup> Graders!
