Student Conduct Agreement

Kannapolis Middle School athletes serve as representatives of our school. Due to this, all athletes and managers are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that meets or exceeds the expectations in the classroom, as a member of our school, as a guest at other schools, and anywhere else that you represent KMS.

Participation in extracurricular activities is a privilege and not a right. Therefore the following consequences have been put in place for any student athlete or manager who is unable to follow the guidelines for proper behavior as stated in the Kannapolis Middle School Student Handbook.

Detention:

1st offense: Loss of playing time as deemed appropriate by your coach

2nd offense and after: Student will sit out 1 game (next game) and meet with an AD before being allowed to participate in practice or games.

Suspension: Removal from team for remainder of season. Student is ineligible to participate in athletics for the remainder of the current semester and the following semester unless an appeal is submitted and granted. **More than one suspension will result in disqualification from all sports. You may only submit ONE appeal per school year.** *(Submission of appeal does not guarantee approval.)

Parent Conduct Agreement

Thank you for allowing your child to participate in a sport that will represent Kannapolis Middle School. In order to provide the most supportive atmosphere and maintain a safe and orderly season for our athletes, we ask that parents/guardians abide by the following expectations:

- All practices are CLOSED. Parents/Guardians are asked to wait at the designated pick up points in the parking lot behind the school. Parents will not be allowed at practices, this includes outdoor practice facilities.
- To provide the greatest amount of safety and accountability, all athletes are expected to be picked up within 15 minutes of the end of practice and games/ return of bus to school from away game.
- Parents/Guardians are expected to be supportive of athletes, coaches and opposing team members at all times. Displays of poor sportsmanship from fans will not be tolerated.

Violations of any of the guidelines above will result in the following consequence:

1st Warning: Athlete will not be allowed to practice until the parent/guardian meets with the coach or one of the athletic directors at the end of practice the following day (NOT during practice time)

2nd Warning: Athlete will not be allowed to practice/participate in games for a period of 1 week.

3rd warning: Athlete will be removed from the team
